

Student Parking Permit Guidelines

Driving and parking at Cornersville High School is a privilege and not a right. All students who drive to school and park on campus must complete the Student Parking Permit Form, show proof of insurance for the vehicle being driven, and obtain a permit. The S.R.O., principal and assistant principal may suspend or revoke a student's privilege to drive and park on campus. If the permit is suspended it can be reinstated after a term set by the administration of the school. If revoked the student may apply for another permit the next semester.

School Citations:

Citations may be issued by the S.R.O or CHS staff. The citations may be written for not following any of the rules listed. Failure to comply with any parking citation will result in a suspension of driving privileges for a minimum of 9 weeks.

Access to Vehicles:

Once a student has entered the building at the start of the school day they will not be permitted to return to their vehicle without permission of the S.R.O., principal or assistant principal. They will sign a paper stating their name and what they are retrieving from the vehicle. Students will be allowed one pass to their car per semester. Any time after that the student will receive two demerits per trip. Permission to leave the building is at the discretion of the school administration.

Rules:

1. Parking Permit must be displayed in front window and be unobstructed.
2. Vehicle must be registered to that parking permit
3. No driving on the curb or grass
4. No parking in staff parking areas
5. Every vehicle must be in a parking spot or if parked in the gravel area must be parked properly in regards to other vehicles.
6. Reckless driving / excessive speed will result in an immediate revocation of parking privileges.
7. School seatbelt citations can be issued on campus
8. Students must observe a 10 mph speed limit on campus

Consequences:

Each student who receives a citation will have five school days to speak with the S.R.O. about the citation.

First Citation: Verbal Warning for offense and 1 hour of campus clean up

Second Citation: Verbal Warning, Parent notification and 3 hours of campus clean up

Third Citation: Suspension of parking privileges for 10 school days and 5 hours campus clean up.

Fourth Citation: Revocation of parking privileges for the rest of the school year and additional school discipline may be administered for the offense.

Seat Belt Citation: Each on campus seatbelt citation will result in 30 minutes of campus clean up per citation. This can be written to passengers who are students without a parking permit.

Reckless driving / excessive speed will result in an immediate revocation of parking privileges!!!!!!
